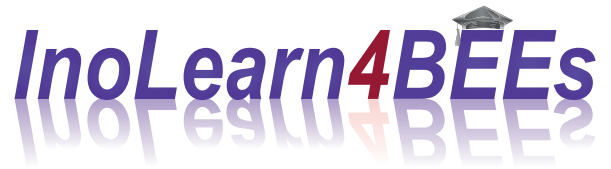

Short description

Through an international partnership between Romania, Bulgaria, Slovakia and Poland, the project «InoLearn4BEEs» envisages an innovative architecture to step up changes in educating Business, Engineering and Entrepreneurship (BEE) students based on a fruitful cooperation between universities and different industries.

The «InoLearn4BEEs» project induces innovation changes through a set of interconnected activities which bring in the center of innovation teachers and experts from four European countries, as well as students and teachers from cross-disciplinary fields of education (Business, Engineering and Entrepreneurship areas), and key stakeholders from local business sector, civil society, public administration and/or governmental entities.



Scope

Improve digital and critical thinking skills of students in Business and Engineering Entrepreneurship (BEE) fields through developing, testing and improving Innovative Student-Centred Learning Practices (SCL), thus facilitating intercultural and civic attitudes.

Transform existing teacher-centred culture into students-centred learning approach used in Business, Engineering & Entrepreneurship (BEE) education areas and curricula, in the multicultural context of Romania, Bulgaria, Slovakia, and Poland.

Stimulate and enhance digital skills and critical thinking in interdisciplinary and intercultural approach by engaging students in Business, Engineering & Entrepreneurship (BEE) education from Romania, Bulgaria, Slovakia and Poland.

Objectives

1. Transform existing teacher-centred culture into student-centred learning
2. Capacitate and elevate students' innovative knowledge, entrepreneurship & digital skills
3. Stimulate and enhance digital skills and critical thinking of students
4. Spread out and multiply project results and benefits

Target

→ Within partner universities:

250 students in BEE education, 30 project staff

→ Within national markets:

74 external stakeholders from the socio-economic environment (business, labour market, civil society, industry, R&D, etc.)

Civil society and public administration representatives from Romania, Bulgaria, Slovakia and Poland

Results

4 dissemination and multiplier events in Slovakia, Romania, Bulgaria and Poland

150 participants in project's events

1 short-term joint staff training event

The effects of «InoLearn4BEEs» will be the virtual integration of innovative learning environment that incorporates ICT-tools, giving more opportunities for interactive learning, students becoming able to resolve cross-disciplinary problems, and to understand multicultural challenges and views.
